Dear Neighbours,

New steel roof works is now underway up on level 9 at Bretttenham House, we have currently used 30 tonnes of steel and by completion of the works we would have used 110 tonnes which is equivalent to one large blue whale which is also 1,500 humans.

- The Project received in the month of April a “Excellent” score from the Considerate Contractors Scheme highlighting our commitment to the Community, Environment and Workforce.
- We have also moved our Site Office; we are now located at the bottom of Savoy Hill under Waterloo Bridge.

Next 12 Weeks Works Schedule:

1. Continuation of External Stone façade repairs & cleaning to all elevations.
2. Scaffolding works to Roof areas and existing stair cores to facilitate access for the works.
3. Removal of existing windows between lower Ground floor level and level 2
4. Installation of “New” windows to levels 2 down to lower ground level.
5. Structural alteration works to form “New lift” Cores at the North & South section of the building.
6. Structural builders work to form “New” Mechanical and Electrical Risers / Cupboards.
7. Blockwork to form “New” internal partitioning walls to all levels.
8. Installation of “New” Steel Roof structure at level 9
9. Removal of existing Basement floor to facilitate the installation of “New” Mechanical & Electrical plant locations.
10. Installation of “New” Rainwater system to all levels.
11. Construction of “New” drainage system in Basement.
12. Completion of the “New” UKPN Substation in the Basement
